



- One of the two Grounds & Maintenance Operators is out on a workers compensation injury claim; adversely impacting our ability to keep up with the daily demands. We have successfully hired a temporary replacement; new person is learning quickly and is of a tremendous help.
- Cleaned flower beds and picked up trash at City parks.
- Nearly complete with pressure washing all city facilities (parks & playgrounds included) with exception of City Hall
- Routine spraying of all parks/properties with weed killer
- Routine spraying or weed killer & insect control at all playgrounds
- Implementing a summer maintenance plan on the ball field turf at Buddy Davis for the off-season; will greatly improve quality of grass/turf on the fields next season
- Routine maintenance conducted at all city parks and on City Hall grounds.
- Working to cleanup 'laydown' area behind City Hall and make better use of or Facilities and creating a more permanent home for all equipment.
- Working to inventory all supplies and consolidate at one central shop for Cultural Services
- Completed equipment 'round-up' for all equipment, vehicles, and tools assigned to Cultural Services. As equipment has located, we have assessed condition, usability, made repairs and assisting with fixed assets inventory.
- Continue safety/maintenance checks on all equipment and making repairs as-needed to bring vehicles & equipment within specification & regulation.
- Have begun expanding new key/locking system to Shepard Park (implemented at Buddy Davis first on a trial basis, then spread to every park & facility city-wide)
- Continued working on plans to better secure Shepard Park with perimeter fencing at unauthorized entry points, access gates, camera systems, etc. This is very much in line with sister cities and other state-funded parks.
