SUBJECT: Public Hearing for Substandard Property Conditions, 3224 & 3228 Willis Drive

ISSUE:

Pursuant to the Mississippi Codes Annotated, 1972 § Title 21, Chapter 19, Section 11, the City Council has set the date of July 17, 2012, in order to conduct a public hearing and receive public comment(s) regarding the abatement of the subject property.

BACKGROUND:

A telephone complaint from a neighbor, concerned with code violations initiated the opening of a code violation file against the property in August 2009. According to Ms. Cooley, the 1940 built home at 3228 Willis has been vacant several years but a tenant was living in a recreational vehicle (RV) at the property until May 2009. The tenant passed away and left all his personal belongings in the RV and the property in terrible condition. The wooden structure located at 3228 Willis Drive remains in a serious state of disrepair and no repairs have been accomplished since the code violation case was opened in August 2009. Code enforcement has discussed the recurring problems with Ms. Cooley by telephone several times but the property remains in violation of the City's Unified Development Ordinance. The property has continued to fall into a state of disrepair and the owner(s) have done nothing to repair the property to the International Building Code standards. Code enforcement has corresponded with the owner(s) at least six times and has received one written reply concerning the code violations. The owner(s) were asked to contact the building and zoning administrator for a complete property inspection and assessment. The property is now subject to the 2009 Digital Flood Insurance Rate Maps (DFIRM), which increased the required elevation for this property.

Other property owners in the vicinity remain concerned with the visible appearance of this dilapidated structure, overgrown property and the potentially dangerous condition. The property owner was mailed a copy of the public hearing letter on June 20, 2012 providing the appropriate notification time. Additionally, the parcel of land and City of Gautier, bulletin board were posted with a copy of the public hearing notice.


RECOMMENDATION:


The City of Gautier, Mayor and City Council has approved and scheduled a public hearing for Tuesday, July 17, 2012, at 6:30 PM. The location for the hearing is the Gautier City Hall, 3330 Highway 90 Gautier, Mississippi 39553. The purpose of this public hearing is to determine whether or not the property referenced above is in such a state of uncleanliness as to be a menace to the public health, safety, and welfare of the community per Mississippi Code Annotated 1972 § Title 21, Chapter 19, Section 11.

If at the scheduled hearing, the governing authority decides the property or parcel of land is in a condition determined to be a menace to the public health, safety, and welfare of the community, the city shall proceed to clean the land by the use of municipal workers or by contract. The scope of the work to be performed may include cutting grass/weeds, removing rubbish, draining cesspools/standing water from the property, removing dilapidated fences/building, removing personal property and other debris from the property.

Additionally, the municipality may reenter the property or parcel of land for a period of one year after the hearing without any further hearings. A notice will be posted on the property or parcel of land and at city hall or another place in the municipality where such notices are generally posted at least seven days before the property or parcel of land is reentered for cleaning.


This property referenced above is in violation of the City of Gautier, minimum property maintenance and appearance standards. This letter will serve as my final notice of violation, you have thirty days to bring the property and structure into compliance with existing building code standards and the City's Unified Development Ordinance or remove the structure from its location. The City of Gautier, Unified Development Ordinance, Article XVI, Section 16.1 Minimum Property Maintenance and Appearance Standards states:

16.1.1 Scope. The provisions of this Article shall apply to all existing residential, commercial and industrial properties and premises and constitute minimum requirements and standards for premises, structures, and facilities for the health, safety, and welfare of the community. The owner or tenant of all real property within the City shall maintain the property and premises in such a manner as to conform to this Article as well as other codes and ordinances in order to avoid blighting influences on neighboring properties and causing depreciation of property values.

16.1.2 Intent. This article shall be construed to secure its expressed intent, which is to ensure public health, safety and welfare as far as they are affected by the continued occupancy and maintenance of structures and premises. Existing structures and premises that do not comply with these provisions shall be repaired or maintenance performed to provide a minimum level of compliance of this article.

Code Enforcement Department is requesting your cooperation in repairing/removing this dilapidated structure in disrepair by June 15, 2012. Failure to comply with city regulations pursuant to Article XVI, Section 16.1, is punishable by fines as imposed by the municipal judge, with each day constituting a new and separate offense. Code Enforcement will be happy to assist you with any questions that you may have.

Your property address referenced above is again in violation of the City of Gautier, zoning ordinances after previously sending you several letters last fall regarding property maintenance codes. On May 17, 2010, the property was observed and found to be over grown with grass/weeds and requires routine cutting. The City of Gautier, Unified Development Ordinance, Article XVI, Section 16.7, Care of Property and Premises States:

"It is unlawful for the owner or occupant of a residential building, structure, or property to utilize the premises of such residential property for the open storage of any abandoned motor vehicle or parts thereof, appliances, building material, building rubbish or similar items." It shall be the duty and responsibility of every such owner or occupant to keep the premises as such residential property clean and to remove from the premises all such abandoned items as listed above, including but not limited to weeds, dead trees, trash, garbage, etc. Furthermore, the general site and/or premises shall be maintained in general with particular references to insuring that appearance will be and remain compatible and harmonious with properties in the general area and will not be so at variance with other properties in the general area as to cause a substantial depreciation of such property values."

A summons to appear in court can be issued if the property is not cleaned within fourteen (14) days. Ms. Cooley,

I received your letter dated September 11, 2009, and understand the situation and family concerns you must take into consideration. I want you to know I am willing to work with you in regards to bringing this property into compliance. On October 27, 2009 the property was re-inspected; the recreational vehicle has been removed, the over grown lots have been cut and most of the trash/debris has been removed. I can clearly see the progress made, however; the dilapidated/unsecured structure remains in the same condition and by state law is classified as an unsafe structure because it is not secure and possibility damaged beyond reasonable repair. I will give you until January 4, 2010, to make a decision on the repair or removal of the structure before I recommend the abatement of the structure as authorized by our Mississippi Code 1972.


Dear Mr. Belles,

I am in receipt of your letter dated 9-8-2009, in which you advise the property at 3224 & 3228 Willis Drive is out of compliance of Appendix A Art. III Section 14.6 Care of premises and property states. I want you to know I am doing the best I can getting the property cleaned up. This is family property that we have owned since the 1958. The canals were dredged at the cost of my father-in-law, Dr. Latroy Cooley, Wally Andrews and Paul Reburte. We have always taken pride in our *fishing camps*. The 3228 property was rented until May of 2009 when the renter passed away and left all his personal belongings including the recreational trailer and the property a *disaster*. The 3224 property had building materials that were salvaged from the Katrina deystoyed house that is no longer at 3224. The material stacked there is for use on the roof of the boat slips.

I am a widow, single mom with no help or resources to make a mass clean up. I have been working steadily in getting the property cleaned up. The grass has been cut and weed eated but you must have missed that time period. My son attends Ole Miss and helped me until he had to leave for school in August. I then paid two men to remove camper, clean up yard and keep grass cut until it "stopped growing" was the agreement. The work isn't done and they are nowhere to be found.

I am well aware of the mess I have to clean up; however, working 50-60 hrs a week and not having dependable help makes it hard to take care of it any quicker than I am doing. If you will please give me until October 9, 2009 I should be able to get the property back in order. Thank you for your time and consideration of my request. Please advise of your decision.
