

I respectfully request that he be allowed to purchase that weapon for the sum of \$1.00 and that it be removed from our inventory.



I respectfully request that the Mayor & City Council consider approving the following request for removing one Glock Model 23 .40 cal serial #PVR645 my duty weapon(Lt. Thomas Spicer)and allowing me to purchase said weapon upon retiring from the Gautier Police Department on or after 07/31/2013 for the purchase price of \$1.00.

This procedure is allowable under Mississippi State Statute 45-9-131 and has been approved in the past council action for other retiring Officers of the Gautier Police Department.

MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972

As Amended

SEC. 45-9-131. Purchase of sidearm by retiring member of municipal or county law enforcement agency.

Upon approval of the governing authorities of the municipality or county, a member of any municipal or county law enforcement agency who retires under any state retirement system or any state-approved retirement system may be allowed to purchase as his personal property one (1) sidearm which was issued to him by the law enforcement agency from which he retired. The governing authorities of the municipality or county shall determine the amount to be paid for the firearm by the retiring member of the law enforcement agency.
