The day of Thanksgiving is fixed by proclamation by the Governor and shall be fixed to correspond to the date proclaimed by the President of the United States. (**Section 3-3-7, Mississippi Code of 1972, Annotated.**) The Governor, at his discretion, designates any additional day(s) for further observance of the Thanksgiving Season by the same proclamation. (3)

In addition to Christmas Day, any day(s) designated, at the Governor's discretion, for the observance of the Christmas Season are fixed by proclamation by the Governor. (1)(2)(3)
