1. REQUEST FOR A CONDITIONAL USE-MAJOR PERMIT FOR A CHURCH IN A TCMU TOWN CENTER MIXED USE DISTRICT, 2800 HIGHWAY 90, (TONY & TENESHA BATISTE, PASTORS OF HOPE COMMUNITY CHURCH) (GPC CASE #11-35-CU)

There came before the Planning Commission a request on the part of Tony and Tenesha Batiste for a Conditional Use-Major permit to operate a church at 2800 Highway 90, Space #1064. Mr. Batiste is pastor of Hope Community Church.

Ms. Batiste advised the Commissioners that the location at 2800 Highway 90 was only temporary. The church hopes to find a permanent location within a year to eighteen months. Commissioner Dailey suggested placing a condition on

the request to review the application in two years if the church needs to remain at that location for an extended time.

The applicants stated that the church would have various outreach programs for the youth. Commissioner Johnson asked how the youth would be monitored while at church functions. The applicant stated that there would be strict rules and that the youth would not be going in and out of the church area unescorted.

Commissioner Spanier made a motion to approve the request with the following conditions:

- a. The physical location of the church and all operations shall be restricted to the location at 2800 Highway 90, Space #1064. Any further expansion shall require the permit to be amended.
- b. An application must be submitted to the Planning Commission within twenty-three (23) months of Council approval if the church needs to remain at the approved location longer than twenty-four (24) months.

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
