52 The speed limit on all streets within the City of Gautier, not otherwise designated, shall be set
53 at twenty-five (25) miles per hour; and

55 The city manager or his designee is hereby authorized to place twenty-five-mph speed limit
56 signs on all streets not otherwise designated, where in his determination, such signs are
57 necessary to assure public safety and well-being.
