

The Intent and Implications of the Gulf Coast Region Utility Act, ten years later.

In the 2006 Regular Session, subsequent to Hurricane Katrina, the Legislature passed the Gulf Coast Region Utility Act, which authorized creation of individual county utility authorities to manage water, wastewater, and storm water in the Gulf Coast counties. The regional utilities were established for water utility consolidation and granted environmental permitting authority within the districts they serve.
