**RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF GAUTIER, MISSISSIPPI TO PERMIT USE OF GAUTIER CITY HALL FOR JACKSON COUNTY CIVIL SERVICE HEARINGS**

**WHEREAS**, the Jackson County Civil Service Commission has requested permission to use Gautier City Hall Council Chambers on occasion to perform investigatory hearings when the facilities are not being utilized for City purposes; and

**WHEREAS**, House Bill 35, 2002, is a Local and Private law authorizing Jackson County and its incorporated municipalities to share governmental equipment, manpower, services and resources as mutually agreed upon; and

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to House Bill 35, it is the desire of the Mayor and Council of the City of Gautier, Mississippi to permit use of Gautier City Hall Council Chambers by the Jackson County Civil Service Commission for investigatory hearings; and

**WHEREAS**, the Mayor and Council of the City of Gautier, Mississippi find that such aid is in the best interest of the citizens and taxpayers of the City;

**BE IT, THEREFORE, RESOLVED** by the Mayor and Council of the City of Gautier, Mississippi, as follows;

1. Jackson Council Civil Service Commission may use Gautier City Hall Council Chambers on occasion to perform investigatory hearings when the facilities are not being utilized for City purposed.
2. Coordination for the availability and use of this facility shall be provided through the Interim City Manager.
3. This resolution shall take effect in accordance with Mississippi state statute.

**BE IT, FURTHER RESOLVED** that the Council authorizes the City Clerk and Interim City Manager to execute all documents necessary for these purposes.
