GAUTIER ROAD CLOSINGS

BRIDGE REPLACEMENT PROJECT BEGINS

- GAUTIER, MS (WLOX) - The Jackson County Road Department is temporarily closing a section of Robert Hiram Drive in Gautier Monday to begin a bridge replacement project. Contract crews will remove the current wooden foundation bridge and install a 92 foot long concrete bridge. Crews will also replace guard rails and improve asphalt leading on and off the bridge. Work is expected to take two months, weather permitting. Drivers will be able to detour around the closed section using a temporary road connecting the west end of Robert Hiram Drive to Amberjack Drive. Everyone is asked to use caution around this construction site. Pay special attention to traffic signs, road workers and heavy equipment.

UNSOLVED CRIME



Gautier Police are searching for a suspect in an armed robbery that occurred Wednesday June 2nd at the “old” Jerry Lee’s grocery store on U.S. 90. Police received a 911 call about the robbery in progress shortly before 9 p.m. and responded. The suspect already had fled the store on foot with an undisclosed amount of money when police officers got the scene. Witnesses told police the suspect entered the store armed with a shotgun and demanding cash. The suspect was described as a black man, about 5 foot 10 and 235 pounds.

SHOULD I CALL THE POLICE?

One of the phrases most commonly heard by our officers while working with the public is *"I thought something was suspicious, but I wasn't sure what to do."* If you have ever found yourself saying this, chances are, you were probably right. Our Officers respond to calls for service 24 hours a day, 7 days a week ranging from harmless situations, to violent felonies. A good rule of thumb to go by when faced with this situation is, when in doubt, call the police. The last thing you want to do is find yourself in a situation where you wished you had called.
